The donations are more than a transaction, it feels like more of a transformative relationship.



Last year the Eastern Bay Community Foundation distributed over \$190,000 to our local community thanks to the generosity of our donors, with over 50 funds giving back to the community forever and 6 scholarships.

Being part of a community, many feel a duty to help others, believing it's simply the right thing to do. Donors are drawn to organisations they trust and where they can see the ripple effect of their donations.
